Key Achievements:

- **EQT Forestry Management Plan:** In collaboration with EQT Corporation, we implemented a forestry management initiative spanning over 1,000 acres, improving biodiversity and carbon sequestration while promoting responsible land stewardship.
- **Wildlife Conservation Programs:** Our zoo continues to support endangered species programs, while our raptor rehabilitation initiative has successfully cared for and reintroduced birds of prey to the wild.
- Water Conservation: Over 20 water bottle filling stations have been installed throughout the park, reducing single-use plastics and encouraging sustainable visitor habits.

- Further invasive species removal to protect native plant life.
- Expansion of our conservation programs to include more community-led reforestation efforts.






Carbon & Energy: Reducing Our Footprint

Oglebay is committed to reducing its carbon footprint through renewable energy investments and operational efficiencies that minimize energy consumption.

Key Achievements:

- IMC Solar Partnership: A future initiative with IMC Solar, LLC, will see the installation of solar panels across key areas of the park, providing long-term energy savings and reducing reliance on fossil fuels.
- **LED Conversion:** All new construction and renovation projects include energy-efficient LED lighting, significantly reducing energy use.
- **Smart Energy Management:** Motion sensor technology has been introduced in low-traffic areas to further optimize energy consumption.

- Expansion of electric vehicle (EV) charging stations to encourage sustainable transportation.
- Integration of advanced energy monitoring systems to track and optimize consumption.





Waste: Reducing, Reusing, and Recycling

Minimizing waste and maximizing resource efficiency are critical to Oglebay's sustainability mission. Through strategic recycling, composting, and waste-reduction initiatives, we are actively working to divert materials from landfills and reduce environmental impact.

Key Achievements:

- **Composting Program:** Initial composting efforts at the zoo have turned organic waste into valuable soil amendments, reducing landfill contributions.
- **Fryer Grease Recycling:** All fryer grease from our food service operations is collected and repurposed, reducing waste and supporting biofuel production.
- **In-Field Biochar:** Processing Forest waste and converting it into a fine-grained charcoal used as fertilizer. This system sequesters carbon emissions for 1,000 years, significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
- **Cardboard Repurposing:** Used cardboard is repurposed for animal bedding at the zoo, demonstrating creative reuse strategies.

- Expansion of composting to include additional food service areas and guest education initiatives.
- Development of a zero-waste strategy for major events held at Oglebay.
